

UKCP Non-Clinical Membership Terms and Conditions

I declare that I:

- am in good standing and have not been subject to any sanction, suspension or disciplinary censure.
- have discontinued my clinical practice and that I do not provide psychotherapy or psychotherapeutic counselling services to any individual or group.
- remain a member of my UKCP college and if applicable, organisational member.
- understand that I cannot claim to be on the UKCP register of psychotherapists and psychotherapeutic counsellors or imply any kind of accreditation by UKCP.
- agree to inform UKCP if and when I intend to return to clinical practice.
- agree to abide by the UKCP continuing professional development requirements as detailed by the UKCP college and if applicable, organisational member through which I am registered.
- have appropriate professional indemnity insurance to cover my area(s) of practice such as supervision or teaching work.
- agree to notify and provide details to UKCP via complaints@ukcp.org.uk and my organisational member, and if applicable my college:
 - of any complaint made against me;
 - if I am charged with any criminal offence;
 - if I am convicted of a criminal offence, receive a conditional discharge, or accept a police caution;
 - of any disciplinary, suspension or practice restriction by an employer, professional body or membership organisation because of concerns relating to my practice, competence or health.
